## Call Updates

We are happy to report that Mr. John Schleis, our third and fourth grade teacher and tech coordinator, returned his call to serve at St. Jacobi and has decided to remain here at Trinity. We ask the Lord of the church to bless St. Jacobi with a teacher to help them meet their ministerial needs.

We were also informed that Mrs. Suzanne Colantonio has decided to return the call that she was extended to serve as our Kindergarten Teacher and School Music Coordinator. The window for us to call another teacher from the field has essentially passed. How are we going to fill our Kindergarten and School Music Coordinator position? The Church Council is bringing a recommendation to the April Budget Voter's Meeting to ask the Assignment Committee to assign us a vicar (previously approved in January) whose wife can fill our school position. Professor Otto has shared that there are 12 vicars up for assignment at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary who have wives interested in teaching during their husband's vicar year. This would be a one-year solution and will enable us to call from the field for a Kindergarten Teacher and School Music Coordinator in October. We will find out whether we are assigned a vicar and vicar's wife team at the May 23 call service at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary.
