Rooted and Growing

Many of you attended our Rooted and Growing Celebration Sunday service – what a wonderful time in the history of our ministry. God certainly has blessed our congregation and all its ministries! He also has led many to respond in a most gracious manner. To date, we have received 113 promise sheets totaling over \$1.042 million. Praise be to God for such a generous response! This entire fund appeal has been a delightful opportunity to unite together with our brothers and sisters of the faith in support of our building improvement plans all in celebration of God's grace. If you have not done so, we encourage you to prayerfully consider returning a promise sheet indicating your intent to participate. Encouragement is given to all members to return their sheet so that we can make sound intelligent decisions about the scope of our ministry in the future.

Financial Update

Our response to the Rooted and Growing Campaign has been tremendous. We now have more than \$1,042,000 promised to support this campaign. To God alone be the glory. At the same time, our general operating budget, the "Trinity Ministry" fund, is currently \$89,000 behind our budgeted need. In an effort to meet our payroll and other expenses, we were forced to withdraw a total of \$33,564 from our Financial Stabilization Fund. May we all continue to reflect on God's grace and consider how we might best support both of these giving opportunities.

Zion and Trinity Lutheran Cemetery

At our last Annual Meeting, the congregation approved developing a partnership with Zion Lutheran in Louis Corners regarding their cemetery. This allows for Trinity members to be buried at Zion-Trinity Cemetery at a very reasonable cost. A single plot is \$250. A double plot is \$500.
